

Membership Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I renew my membership with CORD?

To renew your membership, please follow the instructions below.

To Renew Online:

- 1) Log into the website using your existing email address and password.
- 2) Click the link "View Profile" under your name in the upper right corner of the screen.
- 3) Under "Membership Details", click the link to renew your membership. You may also opt to change your membership level (regular, student, retired, etc.) in this section.
- 4) Follow the prompts to renew your membership.

3. Is there a membership directory available online?

Yes. Current CORD members have access to an online, searchable membership directory. To access the directory, please log into your account using your existing email address and password. Once you are logged in, navigate to the "Members Only" section of the site by clicking the link on the left side of the page. The membership directory is housed within this section.

4. When does my membership expire?

CORD has a rolling membership which means your membership will expire on its anniversary every year (or every two years if you do the two year membership). To verify your expiration date, log into your account and click the link at the upper right to "View Profile".

If you did not receive the most recent copy and you were a current member on the 15th of the month *prior to* the month the journal mailed, please call or email our office.
